


Disappearing Pinwheel Block Tutorial

Select two contrasting fabrics cut square to the Sew the two pieces same size. right sides together. Suggestion — spray-starch both pieces. The cuts in the following steps will be on the bias and starch will help to All seams sewn on this project have a quarter stabilize the edges. inch seam allowance. Note -9.5×9.5 inch starting blocks will result in an 11 inch unfinished block. Cut diagonally in both directions from corner This will yield 4 halfto corner as indicated square triangle (HST) by the solid black lines, sections. creating 4 separate sections. 3 4 Sew the four pieces Press each HST open with seam together in a pinwheel allowances towards the darker fashion to create a single fabric. block. Press. Trim and square up the block, if necessary. The next step is easier if you square it to a size that is divisible by 3. This will result in 5 Cut the block into nine smaller pieces. exact thirds, both Press each piece horizontally and veropen (seam allowtically as indicated by ances towards the the solid black lines. darker fabric). Rearrange the resulting pieces to create a block

pattern of your choice. Sew them together to create a finished block. Press. Trim to re-square your block.
