PAPER PIECED POTTED TULIPS

SUPPLIES

- 1. Sewing machine with open toe presser foot
- 2. Scissors for cutting paper and fabric
- 3. Small ruler with a ¼" line or "Add A Quarter" ruler
- 4. Rotary Cutter
- 5. Small Cutting Mat
- 6. Straight Pins with flat heads
- 7. Seam Ripper
- 8. Thread
- 9. Small Iron and Ironing Mat (optional). There will be a few irons set up in the room.

FABRIC FOR TULIP BLOCK

Background:

- 1. 3 each 4" squares cut diagonally twice
- 2. 3 each 3" squares cut diagonally once

Light print for Tulip Center:

1. 3 each 3" squares

Dark print for Tulip Petals:

- 1. 3 each 3 ½" x 7" rectangles
- 2. 3 each 3 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

FABRIC FOR LEAVES AND STEM BLOCK

Background:

- 1. 6 each 3 ½" x 6" rectangles
- 2. 3 each 3" squares cut once diagonally to make 6 triangles

Dark Green for Stem:

1. 3 each 2" x 6" rectangles

Light Green for Leaves:

1. 6 each 2 ½" x 6" rectangles

FABRIC FOR FLOWER POT BLOCK

Background:

1. 6 each 2" x 6" rectangles

Flower Pot:

- 1. 3 each 6" squares (a darker print for the pot rim would look great)
- 2. 3 each 2 1/2" x 6" rectangles
